









## SMOG BLANKETS THE CITY

Through the first half of the 1900s, air quality in Los Angeles deteriorated at an alarming rate. The thick smog caused health problems for the residents, including irritated eyes and lungs.



Many believed that the factories and oil refineries near the city were the source of the smog, but mitigation measures to reduce emissions from these industries did not result in a reduction in smog in the area.
